Rules & Regulations

Any licence holder infringing these rules will be debarred from taking out another licence and the one they hold will be cancelled immediately.

Fishing methods allowed.

- Fly, running worm and prawn.
- From 1st; July spinning is allowed on waters below the top Weir in The Old Powder Works on The River Mellte and below Junction pool of Pyrddin and Nedd Fechan.

Safety

 Licence holders are reminded that at all times due care and attention must be adhered to while fishing GDAA waters and safety precautions must be taken including the use of adequate foot wear and clothing.

General

- No dogs allowed
- No Gaffs
- Licences are not transferable.
- Fish 9 inches in length or below from snout to fork of tail must be returned to river.
- All Anglers while fishing must produce their licence when requested to do so by any other licence holder or NRW bailiff. They shall also show their fish caught without being asked to do so.
- Fly fishing ONLY between the expiration of the second hour after sunset (fourth hour after sunset in June & July) and beginning of the last hour before sunrise.
- Only one rod at any one time.

Catch Limit

- The number of Trout that can be taken in any one day is limited to two brace/ four fish. Once four fish are kept, anglers must leave the water and not return until the next day when another day ticket must be purchased. If caught ALL out of season trout must be returned to the river.
- Only one Salmon or Sewin can be kept in any one day and that being the first fish
 caught. No Salmon or Sewin can be kept in a net with a view to catch a bigger fish
 later. If fish are returned alive unharmed, fishing may continue, however, after the
 first fish is kept Anglers must leave Association waters and not return until the next
 day when another day licence is purchased.
